Building work that does not require a building consent!

Due to recent law changes in August 2020 there has been a change to Section 41, Section 43 and Schedule 1 of the Building Act 2004. There are certain things you can build without a building consent.

A point to remember is that anything built under these exemptions must still meet the standards of the building act and its large amount of regulations and standards. It must also comply with the local planning rules.
