Peter Lewis began investing in residential property in 1991 and steadily increased his portfolio over subsequent years, always self-managing his rentals. Joining Auckland Property Investment Association in 2011, he was elected on to the Board in 2013 becoming Vice President in 2014, a position he held until 2022. Peter was elected to the New Zealand Property Investors Federation Executive Committee at the AGM in 2015 as one of the two Northern Area Representatives and is currently the Vice President of the Federation. He is active in the formulation of ideas around the future of the rental property industry and the promotion of those policies in both the political arena and in the media. Peter was instrumental in the concept, design and implementation of the NZPIF RentSkills on-line education program. He also has had considerable input into the Federation's current Plan To Fix the Rental Crisis.

Peter will present an update on the current activities of the NZ Property Investors Federation and as a highly experienced property investor will share his wealth of knowledge.

Brooke van Velden MP Deputy Leader of the ACT Party

In Parliament she holds the roles of ACT Party Whip, and is spokesperson for Health, Housing, Foreign Affairs and Trade.

Brooke is qualified in international trade and economics, having graduated from the University of Auckland, with a conjoint Bachelor of Arts and Bachelor of Commerce. She began her career as a corporate affairs consultant, advocating for business

clients facing policy challenges. Her practical and political experience means she knows what big government and rushed laws do to people and businesses. Brooke left the private sector to work in Parliament where she has been credited as the brains behind the End-of-Life Choice Act.

Since being elected in 2020, she has been named the Herald's top performing new MP and described as "making an impact quietly, forcefully," and "proving her worth as a role model to many MPs older than her."

She has opposed the Government's interest deductibility changes for landlords, challenged the Government's Healthy Homes double standards, and has a Member's Bill to share 50% of GST on new builds with the local council that issues the consent to incentivise development and pay for the vital infrastructure that's needed to connect new homes to communities.

Brooke will discuss policy around housing and other matters of interest to property

investors and will spell out ACT's main election goals.




