Here's a glimpse of what will be covered:

- 1. OCR Increases and Inflation Trends: Explore whether recent OCR increases have effectively managed inflation and whether we can anticipate a downward trajectory.
- 2. Interest Rate Projections: Gain insights into the potential speed at which interest rates may decline, and how this could impact mortgage rates and investment strategies.

- 3. Future House Price Trends: Get a comprehensive outlook on house prices over the next couple of years, empowering you to make informed decisions about your property investments.
- 4. Debt-to-Income Rules: Understand the implications of the introduction of debt-to-income rules on the property market, and how it may shape lending practices and investment opportunities.
- 5. Government Policy Changes: Discover the anticipated shifts in the property market following recent changes in government policies, providing clarity on regulatory impacts and investment strategies.

Also to be discussed is the following question -

Inflation Shock: Could we have another rate hike? A week ago, our Reserve Bank (RBNZ) made the only call they were ever going to and kept the Official Cash Rate (OCR) at 5.5% where it has been since May last year. Accompanying it was almost no comment at all and this at least partially would have been that the most important data update in guiding them as to what they should do with the cash rate was coming in a week after they had to announce their decision.



In the current market conditions in New Zealand, a good tip for property investors is to consider investing in areas with strong population growth and infrastructure development. Look for regions where there's a growing demand for housing due to factors like job opportunities, migration or government investment in transportation and amenities.

Look at what's in our own backyard, what better place to invest than Northland, and no better time than now!
